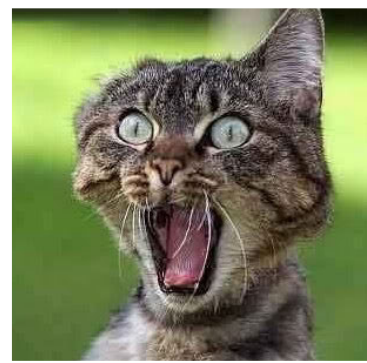


### Learning Outcomes:
