Enjoy Singing? Haven't sung for years? Not sure you can sing at all?

Why not come along and have a go in this three hour 'cappella'* workshop and experience singing in harmony in a friendly environment.

No auditions - no need to be able to read music - no singing experience required - no singing on your own - just be prepared for some great sounds and good fun as we try out a selection of gospel and world music songs!

Led by Claire Stevens, director of *Sunny Side Up*, a group of about 35 amateur singers, is well known for its enthusiasm and energy in performance. The group has built up an extensive repertoire of gospel, African gospel and world music songs and regularly performs at public venues and for private functions in, and occasionally outside of, Dunedin.

Songs come from countries as diverse as Madagascar, South Africa, the Pacific, and Russia, so the group sings in a number of languages. Much of *Sunny Side Up's* gospel repertoire – and all of its inspiration! - comes from Tony Backhouse, a New Zealander internationally renowned for his expertise in gospel and other musical genre, who conducts regular workshops throughout New Zealand, Australia and further afield.

The harmonies and energy of gospel provide enjoyment for all of the group, and we encourage you to share in this experience!

Claire Stevens, director of *Sunny Side Up*, a Dunedin cappella group that specializes in gospel and world music. A former Alexandra resident and member of *Central Singers*, Claire been a member of *Sunny Side Up* for 10 years, and leader for the last three. She is also a member of the *City of Dunedin Choir*, sings in *Southern Consort of Voices* (a small cappella choir), *One Lucky Guy* (an a cappella quartet) and is accompanist for a women's choir.
